Long time Arizona resident and news reporter Bill Williams is running for town council in his hometown of Prescott Valley, AZ

Bill graduated from grade school, high school and college in Phoenix, AZ where he was raised a Christian Conservative and Patriot. He bought a home in Prescott Valley in 2008 to appreciate the area's natural beauty.

Bill knows the community. He served as public information officer for ADOT during critical expansions affecting Prescott Valley residents including State Route 69 widening through town, the Highway 89/69 interchange near the Indian casino, and the remake of the I-17 interchange at Cordes Junction.

“Let’s recognize progress but preserve the beauty of our area,” is Bill’s motto.
